Advanced Cancer Care

AdventHealth Cancer Center Ottawa provides comprehensive outpatient cancer care, including chemotherapy and infusions, to further meet the needs of the Ottawa community and beyond. By collaborating with AdventHealth Cancer Center Shawnee Mission medical oncology providers, we are able to offer the latest advances in cancer care and treatment close to home. This is the first time comprehensive cancer care with infusion has been offered in Ottawa, benefitting approximately 75 patients each year who would otherwise have to travel for their care.
