KALMAR TEST TRACK

Bartlett & West worked with Kalmar to design and construct a test track for the Terminal Tractors that are built at the Ottawa facility. The continuous loop track includes a separate, steep grade ramp to test braking and pulling power and a 200-linear-foot cobblestone area for noise vibration testing.



PROXIMITY PARK

Bartlett & West worked with numerous entities within the community throughout the multi-year planning and development process for the new business park. During design, it was necessary to coordinate with multiple parties to keep the process moving forward in a streamlined fashion to stay on schedule. Engineers, planners, landscape architects and surveyors worked together with community leaders, additional wetland and geotechnical subconsultants along with City and County leadership to facilitate numerous areas of design.



OTTAWA STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Ottawa contracted with Bartlett & West to provide storm sewer modeling, design and contract document for improvements in multiple residential areas. Bartlett & West performed analysis of the watersheds, designed storm sewer extensions and made recommendations for sizing and rehabilitations.



NEOSHO COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE (NCCC)
