The five-year projection for the population in the area is 1,727,968 representing a change of 0.74% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 48.9% male and 51.1% female.

Current average household income is \$88,101 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$96,911 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$35,486 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$39,090 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 56.1% of the 742,966 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.0%, renter occupied; and 9.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 687,285 housing units in the area - 57.0% owner occupied, 33.0% renter occupied, and 10.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.52%. Median home value in the area is \$193,744, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.20% annually to \$215,981.
